Stand Information

Shell scheme stands at LiGHT Expo will be constructed from traditional wooden panels and finished in white.

On the following pages you can see examples of the various layout configurations and stand heights across the event.

Please note that the hall is fully carpeted with dark grey carpet tiles.

Additional floorcovering is NOT included in your shell scheme package, this can be ordered as an extra via the exhibitor manual.

General Notes:

1. There is NO access for wiring behind your stand as this will either be a neighbouring stand OR a venue solid wall. Please ensure that all wiring is undertaken on the 'front' of your walling.

2. If any one side of your stand is 4m wide or over there may be an end panel required on your open edge to keep the wall up.

Depending on the configuration of the block you are located on this will be either 0.5m or 1m. We will advise you of this in advance of the event but please speak with the Ops team if you need more information.

IMPORTANT NOTICE - Traditional Panels Recommended fixings methods are:

Screws, pins, nails & staples. For advice on fixings methods please contact the service desk opposite the organiser's office.

Please ensure all fixings are carefully removed from panels at the close of the show. A charge will be applied if fixings are not removed.

We ask that exhibitors please **DO NOT** use the following fixing methods on panels:
Rawl plugs, cavity fixings and adhesive fixings (e.g. Velcro, double sided tape & any type of adhesive including wallpaper paste).

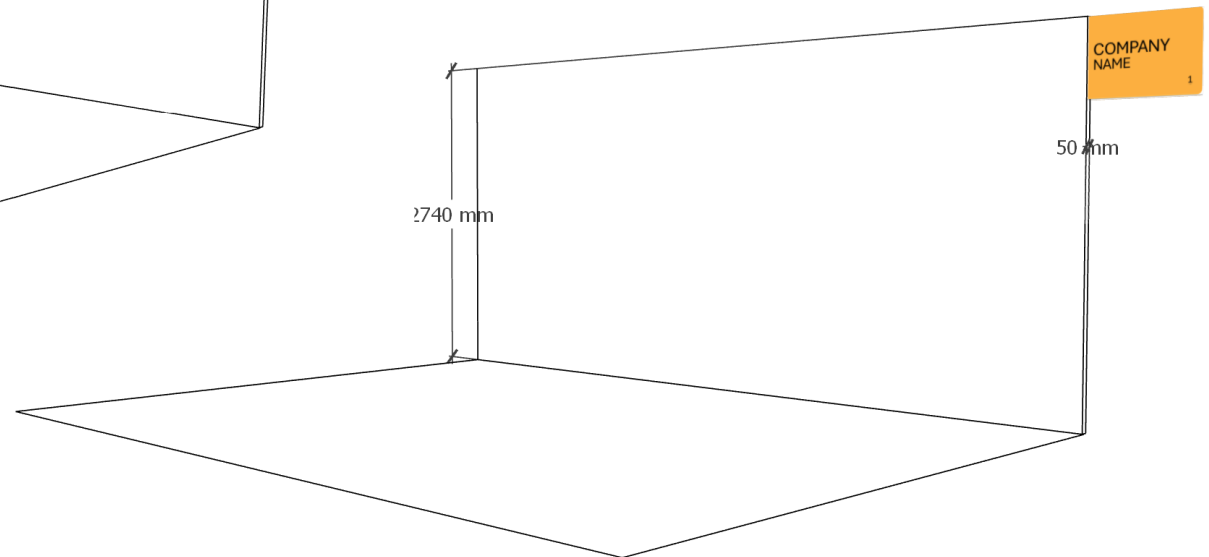
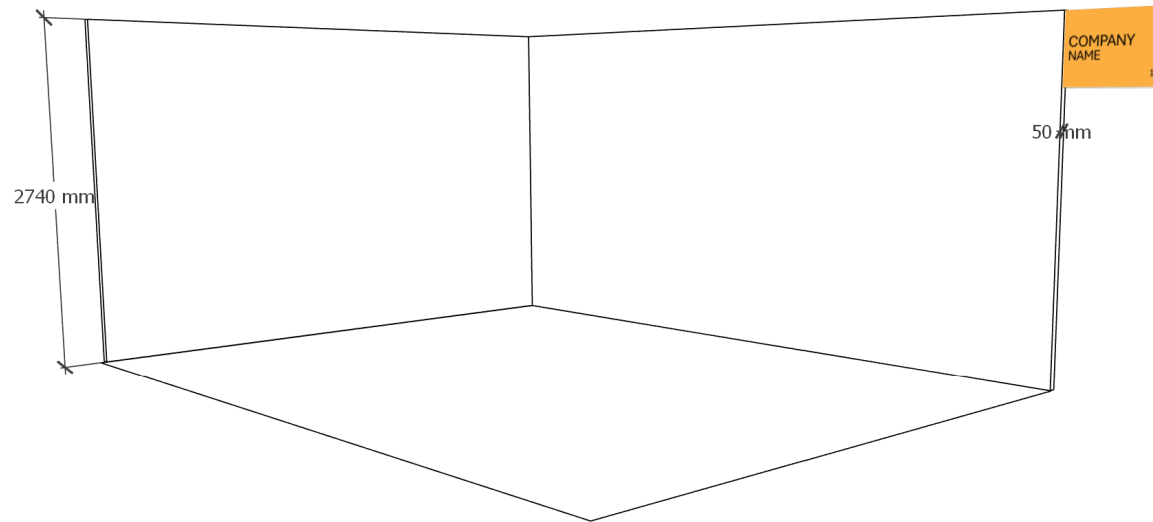

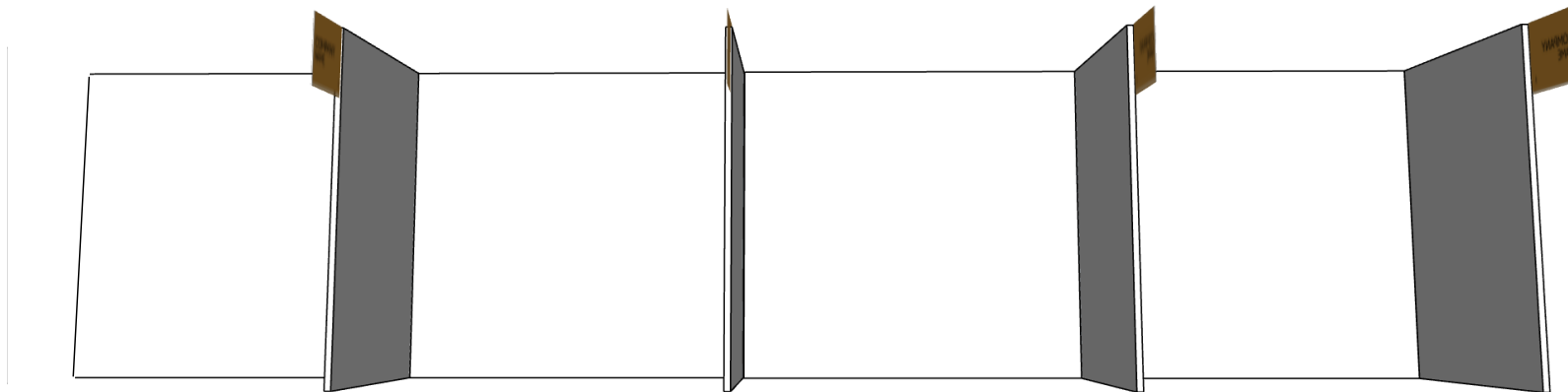
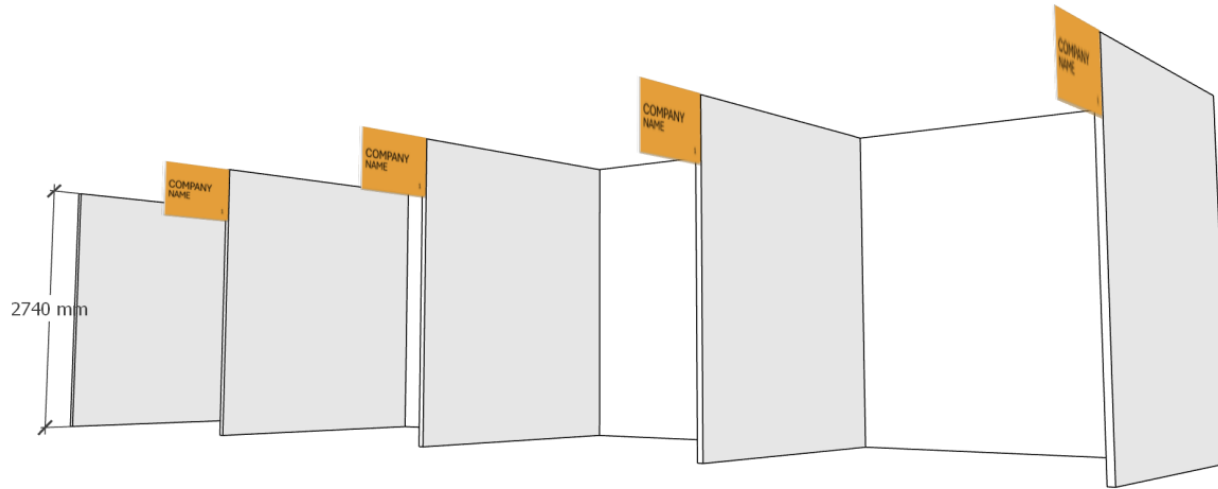
OPEN TWO SIDES

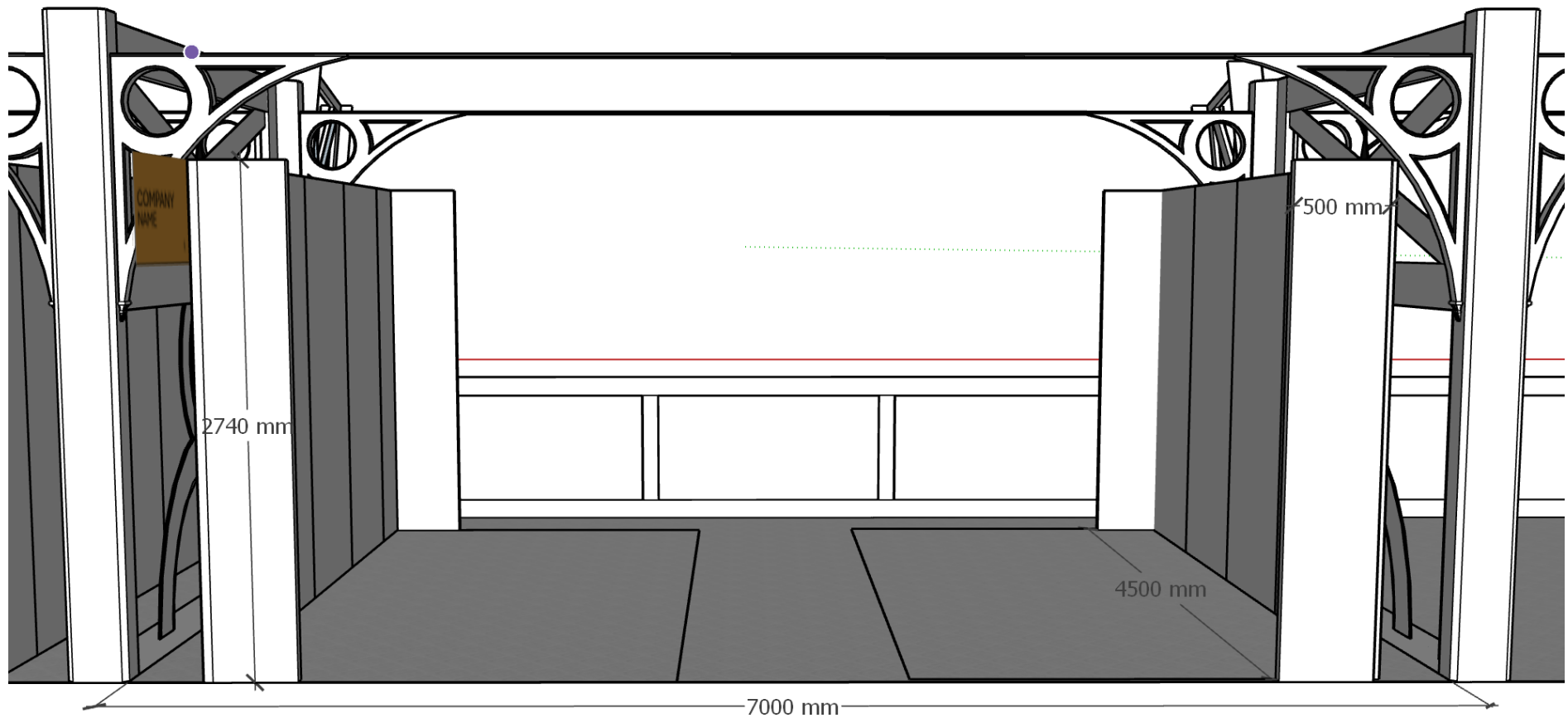

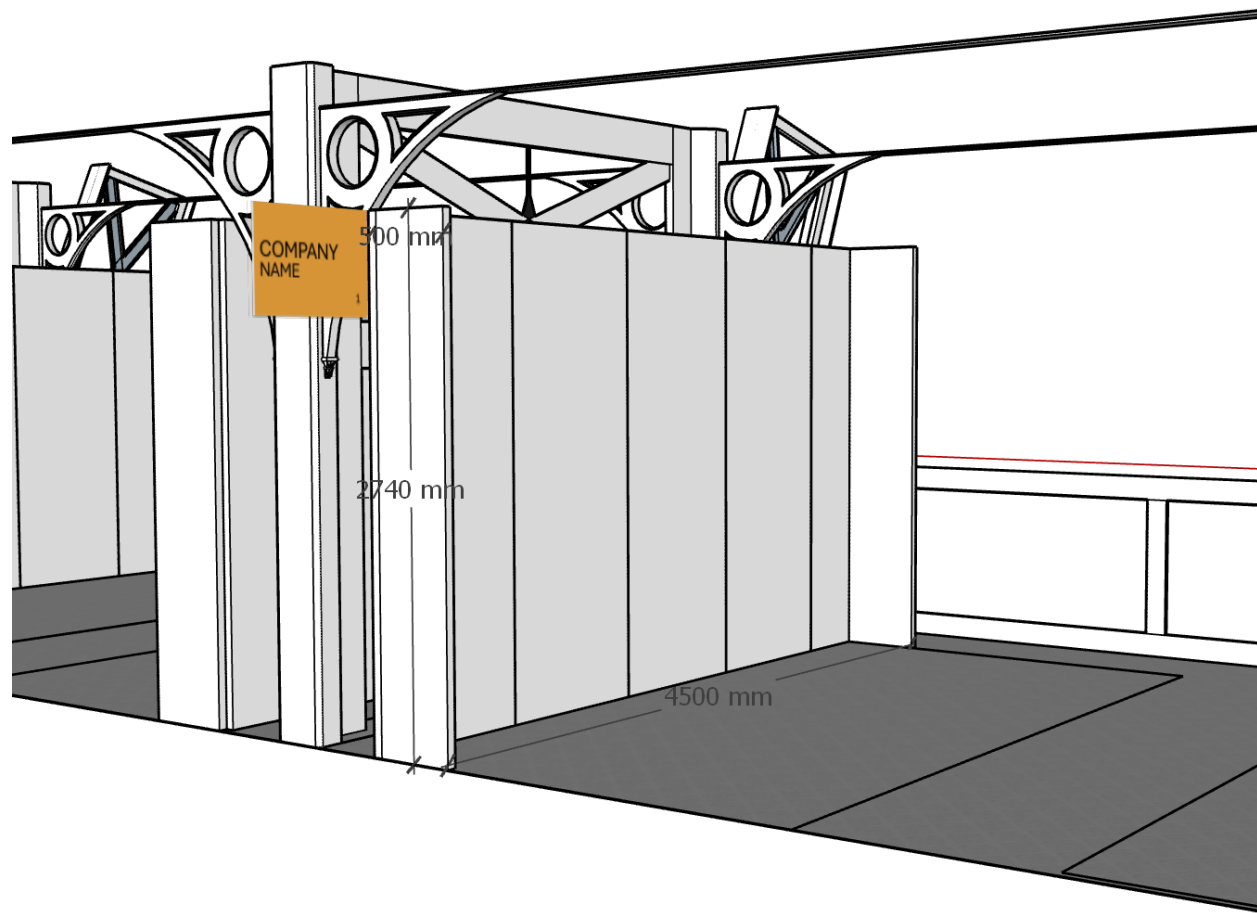

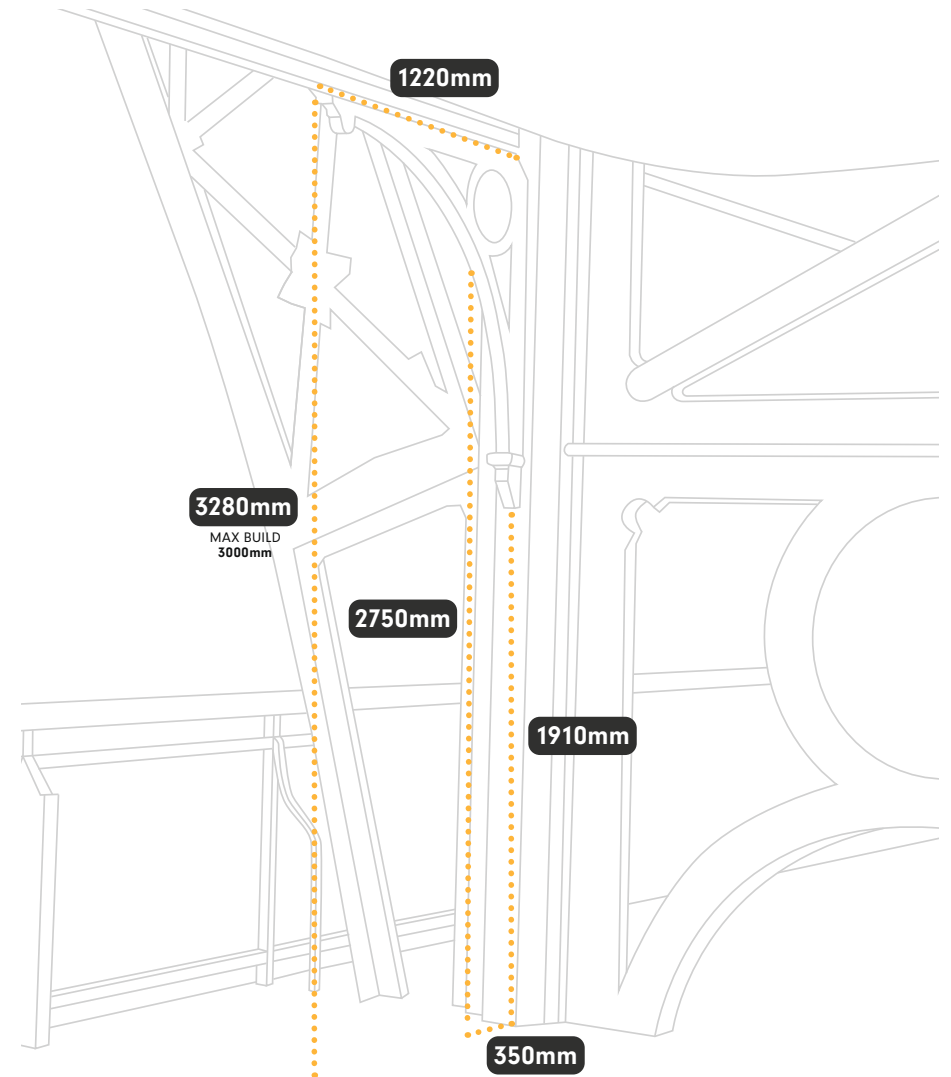

Ironwork Location Within Bay



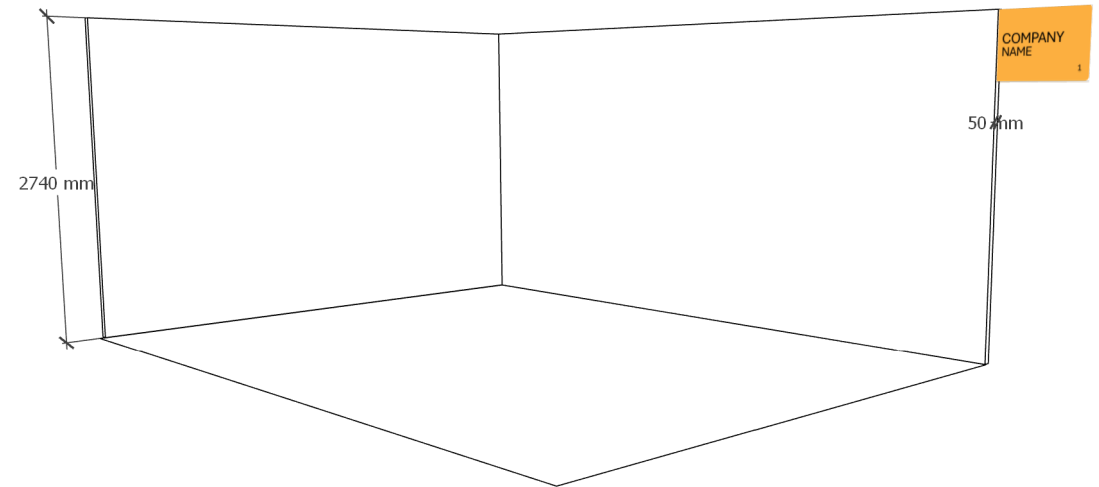
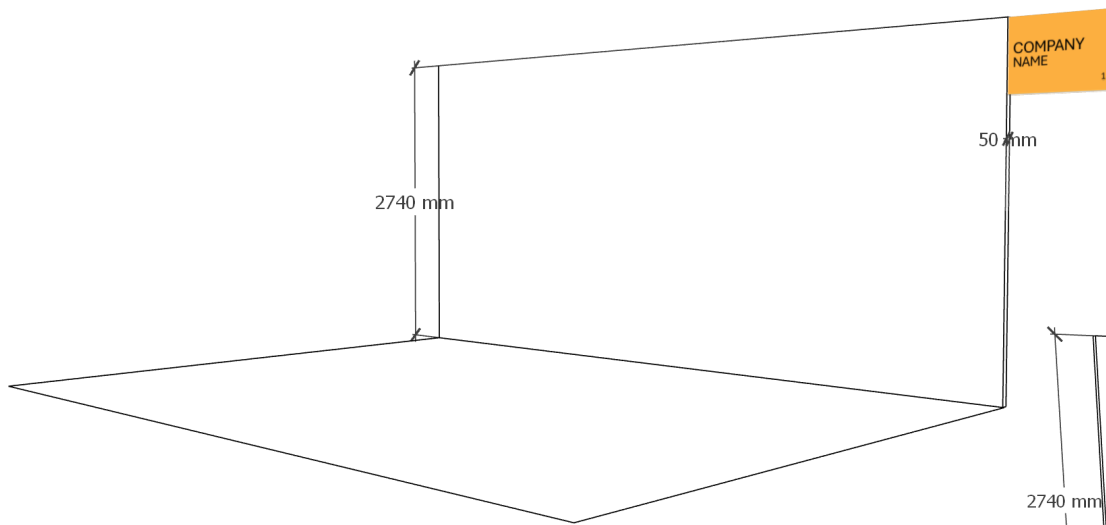
Gallery Bay Ironwork located in each corner of the Gallery Bay. Panels to be cut down in each corner to fit under these areas (see example below).

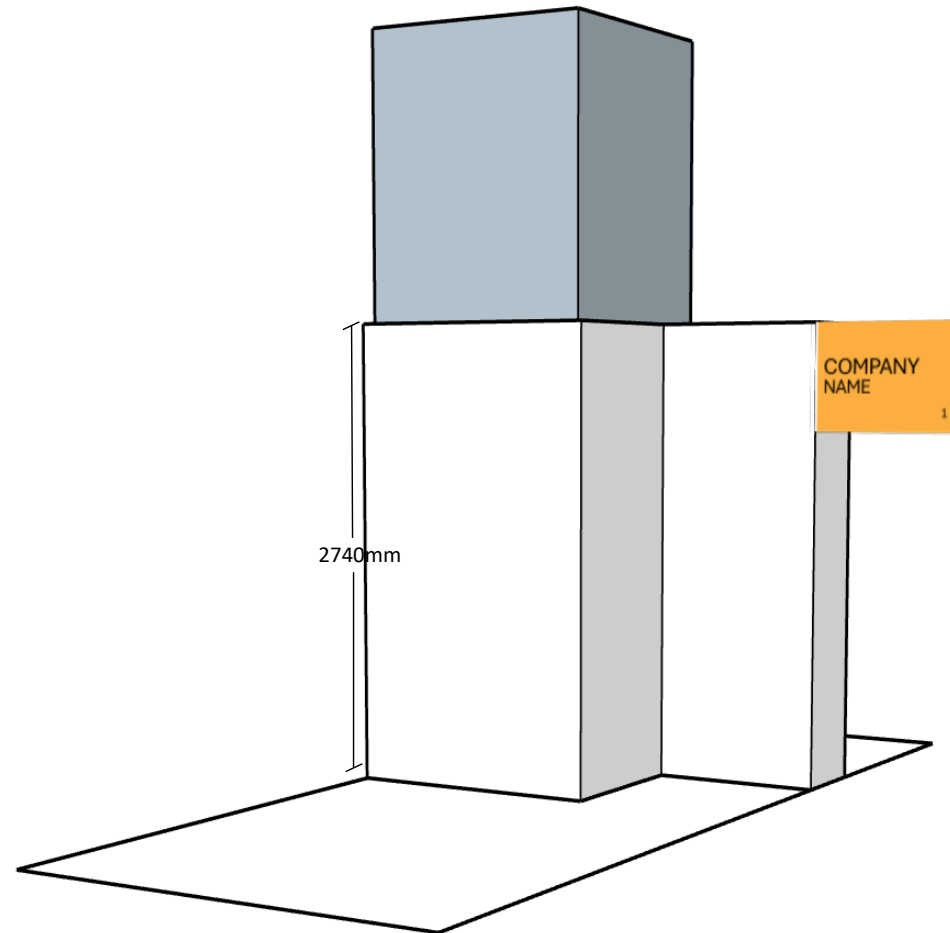

PERIMETER STANDS T1 - T7 & T16 - T32



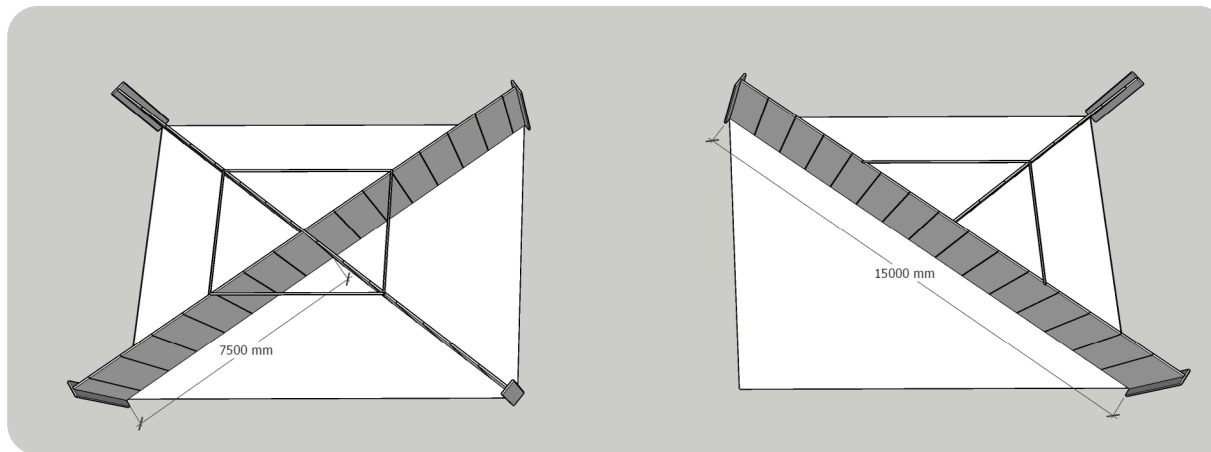
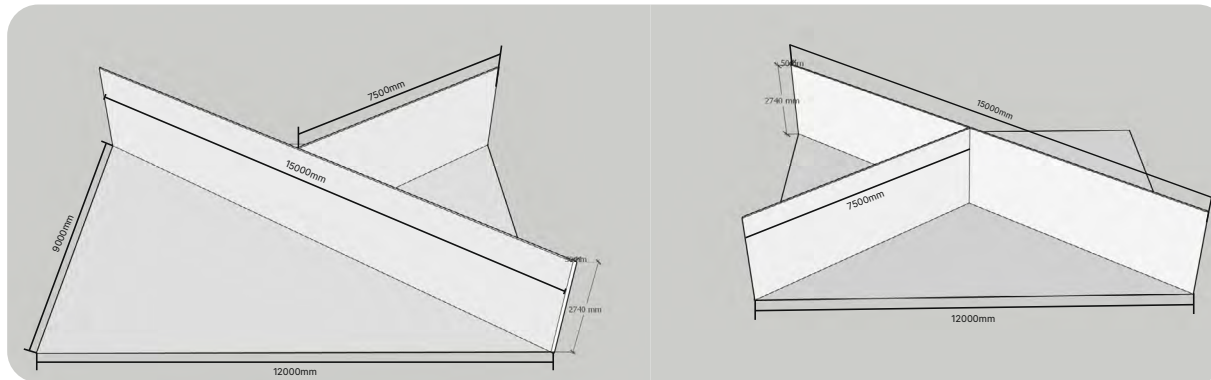

T8 - T15



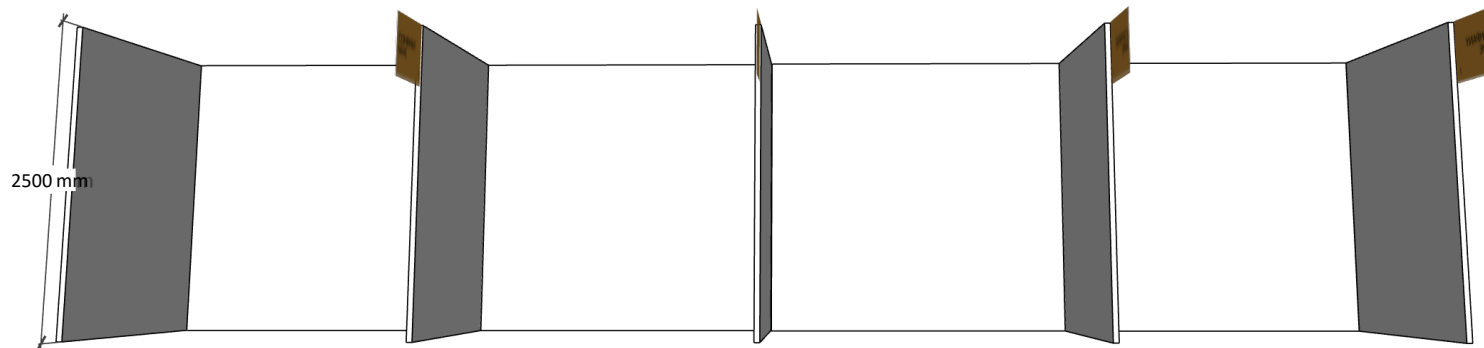
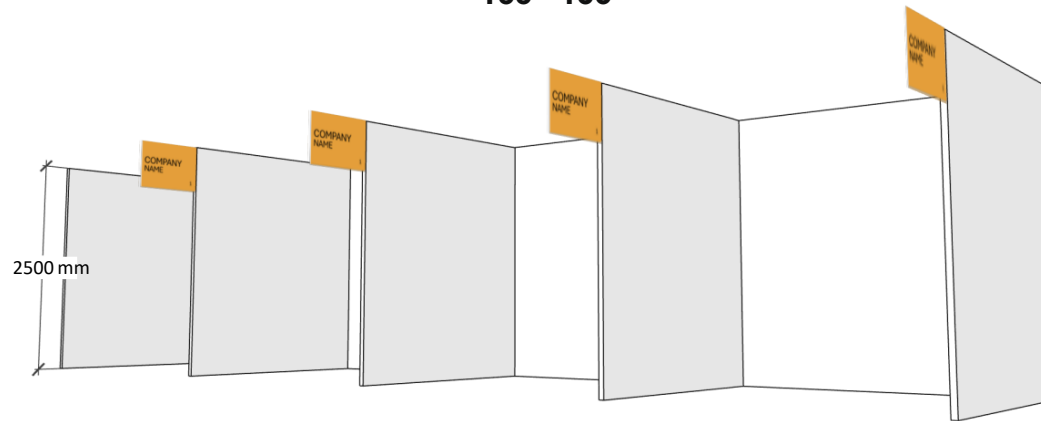
